To do this job you'll need good organising, negotiating and representation skills. You'll need to be good at analysing, planning, and have good decision-making and problem-solving skills. You'll need to be able to work as part of a team but also be comfortable working on your own initiative. You'll need to be able to handle responsibility and be adaptable and resilient in changing situations. You'll have to have good IT skills and a full clean driving licence is essential.

However, above all else, you will need to see this as something more than just a job. It's certainly that, but you'll need to have a set of values and a trade union ethos to ensure you are comfortable working on behalf of workers throughout the island of Ireland.
